Dr. Neal King, a former university president, provides leadership today as Chair, Board of Directors and President Emeritus of the International Association of University Presidents (IAUP). He represents IAUP on an advisory board for the United Nations Economic and Social Council.

King has served in Higher Education administration with Antioch University from 2004-2011, as President of Antioch University Los Angeles and Interim President of Antioch New England, and from 2011-2014 as President of Sofia University USA. Founding director of JFKU's first doctoral program, founding administrator of today's Argosy University Phoenix and Orange, CA campuses, and Provost and VPAA at Rocky Mountain College of Art & Design.

He has served in K-12 settings in Northern CA, London, Laos, and Algeria.

King earned MA and PhD degrees from UC Berkeley, and a BA from St. Mary's College. He has served "in the trenches" in various roles in non-profit, public, private, for-profit and state settings over the last four decades. He understands the dynamic nature of organizations and their need to constantly adapt to evolving environments and market and social conditions.

Dr. King has served on or chaired visiting teams for three of the six US regional accrediting bodies, with an overarching emphasis on quality assurance. Throughout his career, Neal has championed social justice, entrepreneurship, cultural competence, global citizenship, sustainability, transparency, and open communication as core values.

In 2014, he founded Red Turtle Consulting International to focus in international enterprises, concentrating in strategic thinking partnerships with policy makers, CEOs & boards for Higher Education institutions, Spiritual & Mental Health organizations, etc. As consultant, he applies decades of lessons learned and serves an international clientele.
